Service Dog Registration Process

(California Assistance Dog tag)

1. Get your dog licensed first.

- *\$21.00* if spayed/neutered, *\$52.00* if not spayed/neutered
- Bring proof of rabies (and proof of spay/neuter), I.D. and proof of San Francisco residency
- Get license at Animal Care and Control (ACC)
- ACC is at 1200 15th Street @ Alabama Street; 415-554-6364

2. Get a letter from your doctor stating that your dog is a providing a service.

A doctor's letter must have two essential components.

- It must state that you have a disability. The disability does not need to be identified.
- It must state that it is the professional opinion of the provider that is it essential for you to have a service/support animal.

3. Get service dog registration.

- Bring yourself, photo ID, and doctor's letter to ACC
- ACC is at 1200 15th Street @ Alabama Street; 415-554-6364
- Free
- Sign affidavit confirming that you are disabled and that your dog is trained to assist you
- Need to have dog for at least 30 days before you can get service dog tags
- ACC will give you the service dog tags

***You can get the license and the service animal tags at the same time, if you have had the dog for at least 30 days.
